Kington

Between the evening of the Wednesday 25th May 2016 and 8 am on Thursday 26th May 2016 seven shops within the Kington Town area were broken into, 5 arrests have been made and enquiries are continuing.

Between 11am and 12 midday on Sunday 22nd May 2016 a male was working on the roadside cutting and tidying up the verges near to the Headbrook island on the A44 at Kington when his STIHL chainsaw was stolen was from the verge. Incident: 0282S 220516.

Two local teenagers have been arrested for theft of motor vehicle and a burglary dwelling and enquiries are continuing.

Pembridge

Theft - 4 galvanised farm gates have been stolen from a farm in Pembridge. It is believed the theft occurred sometime between 23rd of May and the 25th of May.

Almeley

Between 2200hrs - 2215hrs on Thursday 12th May an Lfor Williams 12 foot trailer has been stolen from a property in Almeley. The trailer displayed a number plate with the last three digits being BBY.

Staunton on Arrow
