4.2 Ward Councillor –

The council has been busy holding extra meetings to discuss the Core Strategy. This has now been adopted and will provide the framework in which the Neighbourhood plan will sit.

I would like to reassure the PC that I am maintaining ongoing pressure on Balfour Beatty to ensure that they carry out road maintenance and repair of potholes etc promptly. This does appear to have improved of late, however I ask that all PC members continue to report any issues to our locality steward – Lara Edwards.

Tony Johnson – leader of the council attended a dinner in the Ward last week and answered questions raised by local residents. He advised of the continuing difficulty of achieving financial cuts whilst maintaining appropriate services in the county. He has high hopes for the establishment of a University in Herefordshire. Buildings appropriate for their administration use have been identified and they are now also looking for sites where student accommodation could be built. Cllr Johnson is optimistic that the University would attract sponsorship from commercial organisations and would bring money and employment into the county.

I am pleased to be part of the newly formed Community Advisory Forum in Kington. The forum meets regularly to promote and inform local people of the facilities and help that is available to them in the Kington Centre. The forum has a number of exciting ideas for services and events within the Centre over the fast approaching Christmas period. 6.1 Lengthsman work in September & October – Check of C1073, 90612, 90614, 90613, C1072.

Grit bin survey. Removal of fly-tipped items. Cleaning round traffic signs.

6.2 Road and drainage defects reported to BB during drive-round on 3.11.15 and actions –

1. 90602: Dig out ditch and jet culvert under road 50m E. of drive to Yew Tree Hall – logged for BB
Needs clearing in field as well – Lara contact Peter Davies

2. 90602: Remove earth piled on verge adjacent to headwall structure at GR231489 – logged for BB

3. 90602: Patch repairs done to poor road surface at W. boundary, but culvert under road not repaired – logged for BB, may need camera

4. 90601: Confirm maintenance responsibility for N. end – considered to be Brilley

5. 90614: Road in bad state – towards Pentre Jack 4 potholes logged for BB – towards High Holborn 2 potholes logged for BB – BB to monitor rest of road

6. 90612: Jet out drainage pipes and empty gullies in vicinity of 'The Rest' – logged for BB
 7. 90612: half way to Crossway Farm – 2 potholes logged for BB
 8. Brunley Close: Breaking up over large areas – 2 potholes logged for BB – entrance to where road splits, Lara add to resurfacing list
 9. C1073: Telephone cable pulled off posts by fallen tree on 6/12/13 at S. boundary is still hanging in tree branches – Lara report to BB for action under NRSWA (New Roads & Street Works Act) – 1 pothole logged for BB
 10. The fly-tipping at the 90602/C1072 junction continues to be a problem – BB aware of problem – please report any fly-tipping to Parish Clerk for forwarding to Lara
 11. Grit bin at GR226481 on 90600 – ground underneath now levelled and bin in correct position – logged for BB to refill
 12. 90604: Collapsed culvert half way between C1073 and entrance to Trenewydd – logged for BB – 1 pothole logged for BB
7. As Claire Parker was unable to attend the meeting on 20 October, it was agreed to leave consideration of the Call for Sites report and future actions until a rescheduled meeting on Thursday 12 November.
 9. The paperwork for application for a Faculty has now been sent to the Diocesan Registrar. As the Clerk was unable to submit in time for the November meeting (due to legal time requirement for the notices to be up), this will now be considered at the January Diocesan Court.
The application for a grant has been submitted so should be considered at the next grant round due end of December.
