- 6.1 Lengthsman work in May-June – Drainage work on U90611, C1073, U90612, U90613; cleaning traffic signs throughout the parish; removed debris and litter from U90611, C1072; repaired road sign C1072.
- 6.2 Road and drainage defects reported to BB –
 90611 - Safety rail at Millhalf Brook Bridge has been demolished by a vehicle hit.
 90611 – Can't properly clear culverts outside Brilley Green Farm entrance due to presence of cables.
 C1072: Jet out culvert under road at Merrie Cottage (GR 264512) - full of silt
 90612: Jet out culverts in vicinity of 'The Rest' – full of silt
 90614: Empty gully chambers and jet out pipes between Llanhedry and Pentre Jack – full of mud
