NEWS/APPEALS

Kington: Incident 0306S 090515

Between the hours of 16:30 on the 8th of May and 13:00 hours on the 9th of May persons unknown have attended the cattle market in Kington and caused damage to a Black Ford Focus registration number: FG54 XCP. Enquiries currently ongoing.

Kington: Appeal for information after burglaries. West Mercia Police are appealing for witnesses and information after three burglaries at business premises in Kington. The incidents happened overnight between 6pm on Thursday 7th of May and 8am on Friday the 8th of May. The first property targeted was Divas and Dudes on Church Street. Offenders forced entry before stealing hundreds of pounds from the till and two pairs of GHD hair straighteners. The second incident occurred at First Impression on the High Street, where offenders forced entry, stole hundreds of pounds in cash and a further two pairs of GHD hair straighteners. Border Bean Coffee Shop on the High Street was also broken into using force and a small amount of money was taken. The incidents are being treated as linked. Anyone with information is asked to call police on 101, quoting incident 135S, 121S and 103S of Friday the 8th of May. Alternatively, information can be given anonymously to Crimestoppers via 0800 555 111 or the website.

News from the blues:

Police have carried out speed enforcement in Kington and Shobdon within the last 4 weeks whereby two motorists were dealt with for speeding. A Kington man has been arrested for criminal damage. Two Kington males are currently being dealt with for theft.

6. C1072 by Penwood – culvert under road is broken – logged for BB drainage
7. C1072 from The Plantation to A438 – 6 pairs of outlet pipes from gullies need jetting – logged for BB
8. C1073 – culvert by Lane Farm, pipe broken – logged for BB drainage
9. C1073 – GR271498 chamber wall collapsed – logged for BB drainage
10. C1073 – GR267502 chamber grating collapsed – logged for BB drainage
11. U90612 – 1x defect – logged for BB
12. U9014 – GR287502 where culvert under road on parish boundary, road edge fallen away – logged for BB to fill with scalplings
13. U90614 – N from junction with U90612 to Perryn – yellow markings on road – Vince to investigate
14. U90613 – from cattlegrid towards Fernhall – needs ditching – recommend letter to National Trust. From grid back to Spring Cottage – logged for BB ditching
15. U90604 – GR257504 culverts under road – logged for jetting and digging out outlet and one outside entrance to Trenewyd
16. U90604 – culvert under road on N side by boundary – logged for BB jetting – not done as in Powys

17. U90602 – 50 m E of Pentremiley entrance, stream onto road needs drainage, plus stream to W of Pentremiley
 18. U90602 – W of Pentregove – culvert under road logged for BB
 19. U90602 – GR234488 stream running onto road at Milhalf Brook – logged for BB drainage
 20. U90602 – GR232487, pothole x1 logged for BB, plus debris from digging out ditch needs removing, logged for BB
 21. U90602 – potholes x7 E and W of Bush Farm entrance logged for BB
 22. U90602 – right on boundary culvert under load broken – logged for BB drainage
 23. U90606 – by Upper Bridge Court, pothole x1 logged for BB
 24. U90606 – GR255484, S of Lower Bridge Court – drainage referral
 25. U90611 – between Little Merthyr and junction with U90608 needs resurfacing, logged for BB
 26. U90611 – GR268486 gully under road cut off and not running into Milhalf Brook – drainage referral
14. Due to major modifications being made to the Core Strategy following Independent Examination, the draft has been withdrawn. Implications of the modifications are that 16 houses will be needed now and a settlement boundary will need to be drawn.
