We undertook :	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *High visibility patrols *Request the community to keep reporting *Deal robustly with youths involved *Prosecute for any offences noted. <p>1/09/15 to date evening patrols carried out by the safer neighbourhood team with a view to disrupting this behaviour, identifying persons responsible and dealing with them accordingly. Regular high visibility patrols in the area of Weobley paying particular attention to the schools and housing estates.</p>

NEWS/APPEALS

(Please note that the below is not every incident/crime reported for Kington Safer Neighbourhood Team) Pembridge:

A specialized hybrid pedal cycle (black with fluorescent green writing, mud guards, small saddle bag under the saddle, pump next to bottle cage) was chained and locked up in a car port has been stolen from an address in Bridge Street Pembridge.

St Mary's Church in Pembridge was also targeted and the offenders have forced entry into a vaulted door causing considerable damage to gain entry and subsequently stole two candle sticks and holders.

Whilst conducting house to house enquires in Pembridge it revealed that there had also been vehicles, an open barn and a shed had been entered all situated close by and subsequently property stolen from within. Property consisting of a Satellite box, sleeping bag and a Sealey solar powered panel.



Kington:

The incident location is a car park in Kington, the victim left his white VW Caddy vehicle parked and secure at the location. Offenders have approached the vehicle and opened the back door and proceeded to steal a Stihl hedge trimmer and Makita radio with battery.

Monkland:

The incident location is a farm in Monkland, offenders have driven a large vehicle onto the farm area and approached a large tractor attachment namely hedge trimmer and used appropriate means hiab/crane facility to lift the item to remove and place onto a vehicle.

Weobley:

Incident 59S 30915 & Incident 87S030915 - Criminal damage to two motor vehicles occurred overnight between the 2nd and 3rd of September in Bearcroft, Weobley.

Vehicles involved were left stationary and unattended at this location by the victims in this residential location. Damage was caused to wing mirrors and rear lights.

Incident 91S30915 - Criminal damage to Weobley High school mini bus which was parked securely on the grounds within Weobley High school.

Damage occurred between the 2nd of September and the 3rd of September 2015.

Damage caused consisted of three smashed windows and one smashed tail light.

Incident 126S 030915 - Criminal damage to a front window of a residential property in Kington road in Weobley between Wednesday the 2nd of September and Thursday the 3rd of September 2015. A stone has been thrown causing the damage.

Unfortunately this is a repeat recent offence for the owners of this property.

Drainage work to 90602, 90604, 90605, C1073. Litter and storm debris removal from 90603 and 90604.
- 6.2 Road and drainage defects reported to BB –
Report from drive-round on 18 August:
1. C1072 to A438, by and past New Inn – repair breaking up – 3x defects logged for BB
 2. C1072 to A438, by Plantation and to junction – multiple defects (9+) logged for BB
 3. U90602 on boundary by Crowther’s Pool – culvert under road blocked – logged for BB
 4. U90602 on boundary by Crowther’s Pool – multiple defects (5+) & 12m stretch of road edge – logged for BB
 5. U90602 by Pentregrove – 2 culverts under road blocked – logged for BB
 6. U90602 by entrance to Pentremiley – new culvert under road needed – logged for BB

7. Meeting on 8 September agreed letters to go to residents to update them and letter to house/land owners re Call for Sites process. All letters sent and Call for Sites now in place, ending 28 September. Any submissions will then be sent to Claire for appraisal and report. Next meeting on Tuesday 13 October at 7.30 pm with Claire attending to advise on either whether to allocate a submitted site or how to take the Draft forward with evidence on not meeting target.
No sites submitted as at 18.9.15. 2 householders have put forward buildings for possible windfall development. Various emails have been received from parishioners unhappy about changes required and they have been encouraged to attend the consultation event when it is arranged.
9. Response received from diocese about Faculty. Next stage is a 28 consultation notice, started 24 September. Research for grant application has turned up only one document in PCC archives – note of public meeting when it was agreed to put up a memorial following a public subscription and notes of all payments made and total raised. Grant application will be made after final check that no further information is available.
12. Report of FAWG sent with agenda. Recommended increase of precept to £11,000 to cover: expected shortfall in Lengthsman funding so current level of service can be maintained; incremental increase in salary costs; and maintaining a reasonable contingency.
13. Recommend letter to be posted to every household to ensure all parishioners are consulted.
