- 1. Apologies and welcome to new members** – No apologies and no new members
- 2. Content of questionnaire** – The content of the questionnaire to go to all household in August was agreed as in accompanying document. The letter to go with the questionnaire was also agreed. The Clerk will type these up and check them with Gemma Webster, Herefordshire Council Neighbourhood Planning Officer assigned to Brilley and then circulate to the SG to check before printing ready for the next meeting. It was agreed that names and phone numbers for the Steering Group members would be put into the letter, so residents have people they can ask about the process.
- 3. Vision and Objectives for NDP** – After consideration of various ideas, it was agreed to use Gareth's suggestion as a draft vision and objectives, subject to adoption by the full Parish Council.

The draft vision is:

Brilley, in 2031, will remain a largely unspoilt, natural and scenic part of Herefordshire primarily undertaking agriculture and tourism, along with an increased focus on home working through internet connectivity

The draft objectives of the Neighbourhood Development Plan in realising the vision are:

- Provision of a range of suitable dwellings
- Enhancement of suitable infrastructure – physical and Broadband
- Protection of open spaces having natural beauty and significance

- 4. Open forum** – Various aspects of the questionnaire process were considered. The Clerk will mark on the map which houses are in the parish so volunteers can be given particular areas to cover, for delivering and collecting questionnaires.
