- 12.1 Lengthsman work in April – Drainage on C1072, C1073 and 90613; removal of storm debris/litter; cleaning/cutting back vegetation from road signs
- 12.2 Road and drainage defects to be followed up on drive-round –  
 90605: All direction signs at A438 junc and at Rhydspence are faded, discoloured and peeling  
 C1072: Direction sign to Millhalf at C1073 junc has lost its white background.  
 Just N. of 90611, the 'Bend to Left' sign has broken fixings. Both it and the 'Road Narrows' sign on the same post are faded and discoloured.  
 Brillley Mountain to N. Bdy – Road edges breaking up for width of approx. 500mm.  
 C1073: Brillley boundary sign opposite '3 Hollies' (100m S. of 90611) has lost letters.  
 GR 274487 – Outfall culvert on N. side of road is full of earth to halfway up pipe. Ditch partially blocked with earth.  
 Ditch around SE corner of junc with Welshwood Farm entrance is silted up to crown level of inlet and outfall culverts.
- 12.4 New website will be online at end of May. Decision of which details for councillors are put on website – landline/mobile, personal/Clerk's email.
- 12.5 The cabinet and defibrillator have been received by the Clerk. A qualified electrician is needed to install the cabinet, hopefully pro bono, in place agreed with village hall committee. Clerk then contacts West Midlands Ambulance Service to arrange training session and advertise time.
- 12.6 Access and parking arrangements in application not acceptable to Highways. Agent working with Highways to try and resolve, if amended arrangements are agreed and submitted, PC will be reconsulted.
