Hereford city roads

Travelling into and through the city has been more challenging than usual in recent weeks and Welsh Water `s continued work on supplying future water supplies to the city will affect our side of the city for some months. However there is positive news with the City link road between Edgar street and Aylestone Hill being opened in December.

The cry has gone up for many decades that Hereford needs a bypass and that is what is being planned. This month sees the start of a six week public consultation on route options to the west of the city with the preferred route identified in April next year.

Last month the south/west section of the bypass, from the A49 to A465, compulsory orders and side orders were agreed with a start date for road building of late 2018. The council has bid for £95 million to the Homes and Community infrastructure fund for the Hereford City western by pass.

The resurfacing of the A380 has been welcomed but hugely disruptive to local residents and businesses. The council has a scheme of compensation for those businesses affected over a period of time.

I drove down the Woodeaves road which has seen a huge impact of diverted vehicles and have contacted both the Council and Balfour to be proactive in trying to repair some of the mess and damage to the road.

However, the pressure will now come on our surfaces so please report any problems on highways or footpaths using the links below or phone 01432261800.

Waste and recycling in Herefordshire

Our local Household Recycling Centres in Leominster and Kington are very successful. Leominster open from Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 6.00pm has up to 500 vehicles per day, with 6,400 tonnes of household waste deposited, 76% of that recycled and the remainder now sent to our joint Herefordshire and Worcestershire energy plant at Hartebury with the contents of our black bins where it is incinerated to create power.

Kington opened Friday, Saturday and Sunday 8.00am to 6.00pm has up to 200 vehicles per day with 1,250 tonnes deposited of which 77% is recycled and the rest sent to Hartebury.

Our green bin contents are sent to a special plant just outside Worcester where it is sorted, packaged and recycled.

7.3 A L Lewis VC Memorial Walk

The suggested route has been passed via HCC to Balfour Beatty (responsible for footpaths in the county) along with a copy of the Plan as to how we will achieve the vision.

A reply has been received offering support but no tangible resources. Advice has been offered on appropriate signage. This is likely to be a small plaque with a VC outline and a way marker.

The next stage is to publicise the intention by talking directly to Landowners and those affected i.e. living in houses mentioned on the route. This will be done in Jan 2018.

A survey of the route will be undertaken with a view to self-help improvements.

A start on the design for the Route Board has been made and approval received for placing this in The Boat Inn car park.

The intention remains to have this Memorial Walk officially opened on the centenary of Allan's death in action on Friday 21st September 2018. This event will form part of the Lewis VC commemoration.
