### **GreenMatthews present 'A Brief History of Music' on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> February at 7.30 pm. £12**

A fun and fast-moving whistle-stop tour of Western musical history - beginning in the Middle Ages and ending up in the 20th century (and incorporating everything in between!). Featuring long forgotten songs and tunes (not to mention jokes!), GreenMatthews paint a vibrant and vivid picture of our musical DNA, mixing the familiar and the obscure, the raucous and the reflective and the courtly and the commonplace. The show combines the vigour of the medieval period, the musical intricacy of the Renaissance, the grandeur of the Baroque and the pomp and bombast of Victoriana. Add to that the wit of Blackadder and '1066 And All That' and the stage is set for a veritable musical feast!

#### **Minari (cert 12A) - Thursday 3rd March at 7.30 pm. £5**

A Korean-American family pursues the American Dream in 1980s rural Arkansas. David (a scene-stealing Alan Kim), a seven-year-old with a heart murmur, moves with his parents and sister from California to a mobile home in the countryside. There, his father Jacob plans to start a farm specialising in Korean vegetables, while his mother Monica frets about money. The arrival of Monica's mother from South Korea, certainly not the grandmother David had in mind, complicates matters further. Gentle, funny and moving, coloured by a child's viewpoint and based on director Lee Isaac Chung's own story, it immerses you in the experience of a family straining to balance dreams with survival.

Doors open 7pm. Bar will be open. Don't forget to bring your own refreshments!
